Designing One's Decolonial Project

>> Sharing from personal experience and approach <<

Step 1. Finding your positionality*

Positionality: a process of obtaining an understanding of where you have come from, your civilised history & cultural background, and where you are now in order to recognise the power you have, and how you can shift this power as an agent (of design)


There is no one Vietnam, no single design history, nor a universal, standardised way of knowledge production.



Colonialist Tactic #1

The <u>repetition</u> of devaluing word choice in the process of historical documentation and the <u>minimisation and disregard of</u> intellectual evolution, including arts and technological progression







Challenge:





Starting your decolonial project:

- 1. Asking yourself some (difficult) questions
- 2. Constantly inquiring about your own work
- 3. Identifying the power structure within your organisation
- 4. Learning how to see and recognise your own power within it
