## Simple Catnip cake

### SERVE 6

2 cups flour  
2 cups sugar  
1/2 teaspoon baking powder  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1/2 cup softened butter, softened  
1 egg  
1 tablespoon vanilla extract  
1 large egg  
1/2 cup catnip  
1 batch Vanilla Buttercream Frosting

#### Preheat the oven and prepare the pan.

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Butter or spray a pan and line the bottom with parchment paper. If you plan to turn the cake out, instead of serving it from the pan, lining it with parchment will ensure the cake releases from the pan easily.

Combine the dry ingredients in a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, and kosher salt.

#### Add the butter.

Mix the softened butter into the dry mixture with a hand mixer until the butter is completely combined and the mixture has a sandy texture.

#### Combine the wet ingredients.

In a medium-sized bowl, beat the egg, measuring cups, vanilla, and catnip. Ingredients are thoroughly combined and homogeneous.

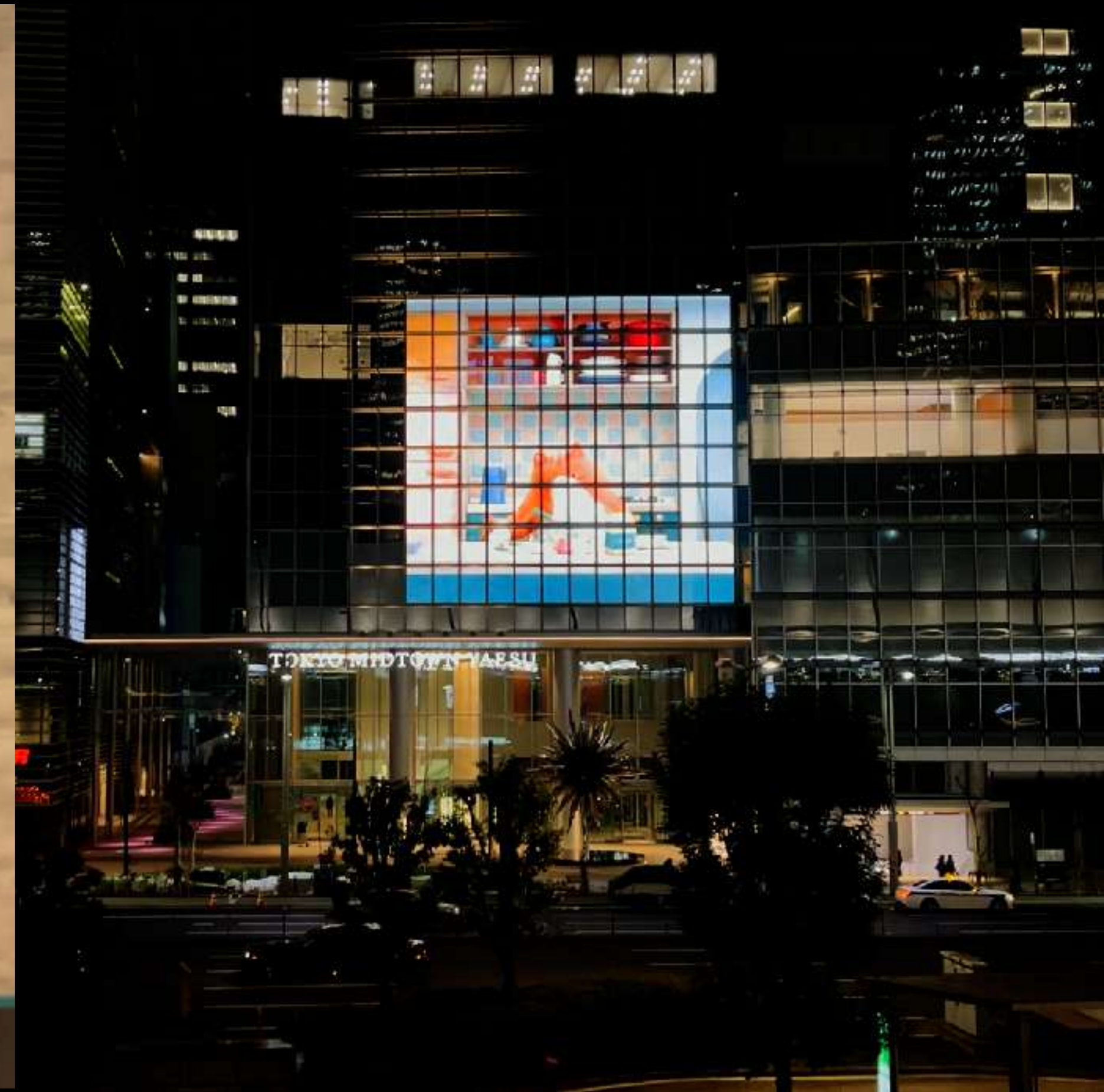
#### Add the wet mix to the dry ingredients.

Pour the wet ingredients into the flour and butter mixture and beat with mixer until just a few streaks of flour remain. Fold in half the batter with spatula.

#### Bake and cool.

Bake the cake for 25 to 30 minutes until the top of the cake springs back to touch and a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.

Remove from the oven and cool completely on a rack before turning out and frosting and decorating.
